I don't see the following pages in your work plan:

spectral_images.htm – This page is to be modeled on the following from the Bambarre site:

http://livingstone.library.ucla.edu/bambarre/files_processed/1r_sharpieratio.htm

At the top, users would have the opportunity to select the natural light/color image from a pull down menu. Once this was selected then from the bottom, users would select a processed image type. The default type would be "ratio_by_940" for the processed image at bottom whenever a new color image was selected at top. The webpage, which demonstrates the rescue of Livingstone's text, is our claim to fame, so it's essential that this page is included.

search.htm – This is not the same as the page currently called search.html (which is really the three versions page). I would like a separate search page for the 1871 diary. I did include a medieval drawing of this previously. If you want me to send again, just let me know. The idea is to make the diary searchable by keyword, but also also by some of the key content (people, tribes and villagers, places and geographical entities, etc.) that is marked up in the xml coding (see xml_guide.htm for more).

Under the **top border**, under the thick black line that separates the title (Livingstone's 1871 Field Diary: A Multipsectral Critical Edition) from the text generated by the individual HTML pages, I'd like the following four linked phrases to appear (the second line here just has the links for the first). They can be spaced out and centered over the 500 pixels that constitute the width of the page. Each should be configured to open in a separate window or, at least, new tab.

5 2. The **left border**:

a. "Livingstone & the Manuscript" – move "& the" to be on the same line as "Manuscript."

b. "Color & Spectral Images" – the underlying link should be "spectral_images.htm" – the last "s" is missing.

c. Under "Three Versions of the Text" add a new line and add "Third Massacre Narrative" and link it to letter_massacre.htm

d. Change "Search the 1871 Field Diary" to "Search the Diary"

e. After "Manuscript Structure" add a new line for "Note on Text Versions" – the underlying link should be "versions_note.htm"

f. "Project History & Archive" move the "&" to the same line as "Archive"

g. "Spectral Image Archive" underlying link should be "livingstone.library.ucla.edu/livingstone_archive/" – this should also be configured to open in a new

h. Change "Feedback" to "Contact Us" and the underlying link to "contact_us.htm". Also place this above "Spectral Image Archive" so that the archive comes last.

3. A number of statements and the NEH and BA logos need to be added to the left border, below where it currently says "Feedback." I attached a separate zip file **Left Border Addition** that provides the text and logos. The statement about the Beards/Creative Commons can be removed.

For now, the "Document for Download" found in the Project History & Archive files *and* in the Site Guide are not linked at all. I would like all these documents to automatically download when clicked rather than to open in a new tab. If you tell me how to do this, I'll go ahead and reconfigure the HTML files appropriately.

a. There should be a double space after the leading paragraph.

b. *After* each header title, there should be 1 1/2 spaces.

2. Vertical line on left is gray. Horizontal line at top is black. Both should be black.

3. Bring all three texts up closer to horizontal black line to match other pages.

4. The width of the left side bar should be static to match other pages and should not change to have text wrap when browser is resized.

5. The three versions should be named as follows at the top:

6. Is it possible to separate the title and search box for each column from the scrolling text, so it remains at the top of the column no matter where you scroll to?

7. The text from the <figDesc> element in the XML files should not appear in the transcriptions here.

8. The values of "cancelled" and "strikethrough" from the @type should not appear in the text here.

9. Text that is rendered as "ul" in the XML should be underlined here, not made italic.

10. The @cert values "low" "medium" "high" should not appear in the text here.

11. The @rend value also seems to be showing up as the text "sup" in the transcriptions, rather than the relevant text being superscript.

12. The size of the text in black at the far top of the page that says "UCLA Library > Digital Collections > David Livingstone > Letter from Bambarre" should match the other site pages. Also the last bit should be "1871 Field Diary" NOT "Letter from Bambarre"

- 26 1. change folder and page name to 1871diary/transcriptions.htm P
- 27 2. Vertical line on left is gray. Horizontal line at top is gray. Both should be black. E
- 28 3. Please remove the text above the image that says "DLC297c_133-102_001r-b" etc. and close up the gap between the image and the horizontal black line. P
- 29 4. Above the image, for each cropped page of the diary, there should be a link that says "Open Uncropped Image". This would then open a new half window in which users could view the entire ratio_by_940 image, not just the cropped half with the zoomify window, etc. P + L
- 30 5. The width of the left side bar should be static to match other pages and should not change to have text wrap when browser is resized. E
- 31 6. Although I understand the need for the small image that allows users to see the viewed text in relation to the rest of the page, I would prefer it elsewhere. Here's the layout I suggest. P
 - a. On left, the image. Cur the area by which it's viewable by about a quarter. The viewing area now is too wide and it's cramping the transcription on the right into a much too skinny column.
 - b. On the right, the transcription area should be enlarged by the amount of space taken from the image viewing area. The transcription area should be wide enough so that most of the text here does not wrap.
 - c. Change the text above the transcription to read only "1871 Field Diary". This and the pull down menu below it can be on the right side of the area above the transcription. After the transcription is widened as described in #6b above, the little graphic for the full page can fit on the left side above the transcription. So in other words, you'll have the graphic on the left, "1871 Field Diary" and the pull-down menu on the right, all above the transcription. This will also get the viewing graphic out of the way of the cropped page image.
- X 7. If the text does wrap have it be indented with the rest of the text, rather than going out into the area where the line numbers are.
- 32 8. In the transcription, the @rend value "ul" should be rendered as underline, not italics. It also looks like now the @rend value of "sup" is not being followed. P or L
- 33 9. The pull down menu should not have the Roman numerals, but the specific page numbers from the list I provided previously. For instance, 297c/112 etc. The whole critical edition is geared to these latter page numbers. Same for the italicized red text that appears above the transcriptions. L
- 34 10. In the transcription, alternate text in brackets should not have a space before and after the text. So [text] NOT [text] P or L
- 35 11. The text from the <figDesc> element in the XML files should note appear in the transcriptions. P or L
- 36 ADDED BY LISA: Resolve MAC Firefox problem (search.html and pagination.html) P or E
- 37 ADDED BY LISA: fix all problems with images missing from the page-by-page view
